## **APM Terminals Inland Services, South Asia organizes CSR initiatives under 'I - Care'**

This initiative impacted over 1000 lives with nearly 450 new prescriptions and free eyeglasses, and a number of cataracts diagnosed. "This initiative was particularly beneficial to the truck drivers from a safety point of view - one of the core CSR causes of APM Terminals Inland Services, commented R K Sreedhar, MD and CFO, APM Terminals India Pvt. Ltd.

APM Terminals Inland Services, South Asia partnered with several social organizations including NGOs and other local hospitals and institutes to make the camp a success.
